Drop Off & Pick Up reminders

Please remember our safety procedures when dropping off and picking up your children. Our doors open at 7:10 each day. No child should be dropped off before this time, as there is no adult supervision before then. Use only the right drop off lane until 7:30, when safety patrol and staff arrive to supervise both lanes. If utilizing the left lane, please have your child exit the right side of your car so that they can be seen by the safety monitor at the front of the line. Please ensure that your student is ready to exit your vehicle when entering the line. The first four stalls are to unload with each cycle. Parents who are parking to drop off must walk students to the cross walk. Please never cross anywhere other than at the crosswalk. Also, students are never to be dropped off in the parking lot and sent to cross on their own. Thank you for your help in ensuring student safety.
